## INTRODUCTION

Olive Trujillo Vlahovich was born in the Trujillo Adobe in 1906. The adobe belonged first to her grandparents, Teodoro and Peregrina Trujillo, and then to her parents, Antonino and Eloise Castillo Trujillo, who came to live there in 1903. It is possible that Aunt Olive's grandparents built the adobe after the flood of 1862. Three of Aunt Olive's brothers and sisters were also born in the adobe before the family moved to Highgrove in 1913.
